### 3. 活動内容

#### (1) 1年間の主な活動内容について記載願います。

1. United Nations Understanding (Peace and human rights, environment, sustainable development, climate change, etc.)

KGN sponsored and organized the 26<sup>th</sup> annual Kansai High School Model United Nations, June 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, at the Kyoto International Conference Center.

- Agenda: Protecting the Rights of Refugees
- Over 300 high school students from 10 Japanese high schools
- English event
- KGN students served as student leaders, participating as pages, delegates, bloc leaders, secretaries and assembly presidents.
- KGN teachers organized workshops to train participating teachers.
- KGN students spent 12 weeks preparing for the KHSMUN. English preparations included: United Nations research, country research, agenda research, presentations, and debate workshops.

2. International Exchange (International understanding)

KGN students and teachers participated in numerous international exchange opportunities both abroad and in Japan.

- 1<sup>st</sup> year students (60 students) in the Course of International and Cultural Studies participated in a 6-week study experience in Auckland, New Zealand.
- KGN students participated in 1-year study abroad programs in New Zealand, Canada, and the United States.
- KGN students visited Boston, Ma. for a short-term study experience.
- KGN hosted numerous students and students groups, for both short-term and long-term exchanges, from New Zealand, Canada and the United States on the KGN campus.
- KGN students began an on-going online exchange project with students from Kepala Batas Sains High School in Penang, Malaysia.

3. UNESCO Club (Community involvement, environment awareness, ESD activities)

**KGN's UNESCO Club grew from 4 students in 2014 to over 20 in 2016. Students organized and participated in various activities related to ESD.**

- **Students organized a workshop with Kyoto City on 'Reducing Waste on Campus'.**
- Students organized 2 campus-wide 'electronics recycling' collection campaigns in cooperation with Kyoto City.
- Students organized activities for the annual KGN Culture Festival to become officially designated as an **'Eco-Event' by Kyoto City. Working with KGN's student council, UNESCO Club students organized the use of re-use plates and cups during the annual festival with a goal of reducing waste.**
- Students participated in the Gomi-Zero project during Kyoto's annual Gion Festival, encouraging the use of re-use cups and dishes with the festival's food vendors, separating trash, and staffing the eco-booths that promoted the concept of an 'Eco-Event'.

- Students participated in the 1<sup>st</sup> annual ASPnet Kyoto Student Workshop at Kamigamo Shrine, a one-day event for students from the 6 Kyoto UNESCO high schools to come together for an active-learning workshop, school presentations on ESD activities, and an educational tour of Kamigamo Shrine, a designated UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site.

#### 4. Traditional Culture Understanding (World Heritage)

KGN students participated in both curricular and after-school activities designed to foster an appreciation for Japanese culture and culture understanding.

- Students in the Course of International and Cultural Studies studied Japanese Tea Ceremony with Omotesenke twice a month for two years.
- KGN students organized and conducted workshops on Japanese Tea Ceremony at 4 exchange schools in Auckland, New Zealand.
- Students in the Course of International and Cultural Studies participated in a Zazen and Buddhism workshop at Daitokuji Temple.
- Students organized tours of various cultural sites around Kyoto, including Tenryuji, Kinkakuji, Kiyomizu Dera and Kamigamo Shrine for visiting international students.
- Students visited the National Museum of Ethnology in Osaka to research different cultures for class presentations.
- Students listened to JICA Volunteer presentations on the topic of Cultural Awareness and Sustainable Development in Fiji, Marshall Islands, and Kenya.

#### 5. UNESCO ASPnet **京都** (Community involvement, ESD activities)

- KGN teachers organized and participated in the regular meetings of the Kyoto ASPnet UNESCO Schools organization, which was founded to create a network of Kyoto UNESCO high schools and the Kyoto UNESCO Association to share resources on ESD and organize workshops and events for students and teachers.
- KGN students and teachers participated in the 1<sup>st</sup> annual UNESCO ASPnet **京都** workshop held in November at Kamigamo Shrine. Students participated in active-learning workshops on Kyoto and sustainability, gave presentations on ESD activities at KGN, and toured Kamigamo Shrine.
