Objective(s) (交流目的)	Our school, designated as a Super Science High School (SSH), aims to cultivate science and technology professionals with a global and local perspective to pioneer the future of Yamagata. Since 2021, we have been engaging in exchange activities with Nonghinwittayakom School in Thailand as our overseas collaborative partner. Through both in-person and online interactions, the exchange between our schools fosters crosscultural understanding. Additionally, by emphasizing Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), we aim to enhance the mutual interest in science and technology among students from both schools through an understanding of the research conducted. The ultimate goal is to prepare students for future
Details (交流内容)	① Starting from 2022, our school has been hosting the International English Presentation Competition (START). In the current school year, two students and three teachers from Nonghinwittayakom School visited our school. They participated in various activities, including a welcome reception organized by the student council, sightseeing, and research presentations with Q&A sessions at the competition. Notably, in Room 1 (one of the five designated areas), they were awarded the second position. Although it was a short stay, the visiting students had the opportunity to experience homestays at our school's students. ② The Future Creation Project Results Presentation at Yamagata Prefectural Touohgakkan Jr.& Sr. High School in Japan in the Reiwa 5th year served as a comprehensive overview of the investigative activities conducted by our school as a Super Science High School (SSH). This event brought together all students from 3rd-year middle school to 2nd-year high school for

	representative presentations. Notably, the award-winning students from Nonghinwittayakom School, recognized at START, presented their findings online. The event also featured speeches from the school principal and introductions by other students.
Results (交流の成果)	Not only through online exchanges but also by having the Thai students visit our school to participate in the competition, opportunities for face-to-face communication were created between members of the student council and the students from Thailand. They had the chance to exchange contact information and have continued their interactions since then. Some of the students who initially met during this exchange even took on the role of emcees for the Future Creation Project Results Presentation, contributing to the smooth progress of the event. Although START 2023 was held on a Saturday, limiting the number of students who could attend in person, observing the presentations of the Thai students at the results presentation provided a renewed appreciation for the collaborative efforts with overseas schools. Witnessing the high level of research conducted by the Thai students served as a significant source of inspiration.
Challenges and how they were overcome (交流にあたり困難だったこと、克服した方法)	Finding out homestay hosting families turned out to be unexpectedly challenging, as there were fewer volunteers than anticipated. Initially, the consideration was limited to families of high school students, but eventually, the scope was expanded to include families of middle school students to address the shortage. For the Reiwa 6th school year, in addition to their participating
