Challenges & Solutions	During the exchange, students encountered some challenges due to differences in communication styles between Koreans and Japanese—for example, Japanese students tended to express their opinions more reservedly. To prevent misunderstandings and foster mutual understanding, the characteristics of Japanese communication styles were explained to the students.
Future Plans (*Follow-up Schedule, Additional Exchange Measures)	 Japanese Culture Learning: Students freely chose books to read and discuss, followed by activities to understand aspects of Japanese daily life, traditional culture, and cultural values/spiritual mindset. Global Citizenship Education: After studying the book "Becoming a Global Citizen in the Classroom: Middle School Edition", students participated in a team-based quiz competition. Upcoming Exchange Visit in March 2025: As there is a planned in-person exchange with Ueda Nishi High School in March 2025, a face-to-face meeting with the students is being arranged.
