Details	BSU students visited the Kansai region of Japan for two primary purposes - (i.) to attend the Osaka World Expo, and (ii.) to visit two universities offering courses in English.
Results	BSU students had the opportunity to interact with students from the Junior High School at Otemon Gakuin JH and SH School.

Challenges and how they were overcome	English language - Otemon Gakuin students were emerging English language learners, where as BSU students study in an almost exclusive English learning environment. Gestures, use of student/teacher translation, were used to support communication between the students.
Future plans and visions	BSU is currently reviewing its accreditations and memberships - Interact (Rotary Club), Red Cross, UNICEF and others. Once complete the school will look to reach out and develop projects with Otemon Gakuin, along with schools it has worked with previously in Nagoya, Japan.
