2026 Teacher Professional Development Programme in Intangible Cultural Heritage (ICH) Education

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

- The International Centre for UNESCO ASPnet (ICUA) and the UNESCO Chair in Comparative Education at the University of Hong Kong are organizing a professional development programme in Hong Kong this August for ASPnet school leaders and teachers. The programme will explore how Intangible Cultural Heritage (ICH) education can be strengthened through curriculum innovation, pedagogical exchange, and community-connected learning, while deepening understanding of the links between ICH and Education for Sustainable Development (ESD).
- **Dates and Venue:** 1–5 August 2026 in Hong Kong, China; **Format:** In-person (up to 25 participants); **Language:** English
- **Nomination process:** Interested ASPnet schools or teachers are invited to complete the official [nomination form](#) and submit it, together with the required [supporting materials](#), to their respective ASPnet National Coordinator for endorsement.
- **Nomination Deadline:** National Coordinators need to submit endorsed nomination packages to ICUA via email at ICUA_ICH@163.com on a **rolling basis**. Submissions will be reviewed in **weekly rounds**, and the **final deadline is 25 June 2026**.
- Please note that selected in-person participants will receive local hospitality support, including accommodation, local transportation, programme activity costs, and an invitation to the farewell dinner. There is no registration fee; however, participants are responsible for their own international travel, visa fees, insurance, and any additional personal expenses.
